

## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- **The Bluegrass State Games is an ASA Sanctioned Event. If you are not already sanctioned, you must do so before playing.**
- **ASA/KHSAA Rule will be enforced unless otherwise noted.**
- **Home Team will keep the Official Scorebook**
- **A Player is only allowed to play on one roster for the Tournament.**
- **You may Roster Bat or use the following should you select to: Bat 9 in the Line-Up with 2 EP's giving you 11 in the Batting Order.**
- **An EP has free Substitution Rights. They can be moved in and out of the game without being reported.**
- **A Courtesy Runner can be used for the Pitcher and Catcher. However, it must be a Player not in the Line-Up. If there are no such Players available, then the last batted out will be used.**
- **Time Limit is 1 hour and 15 minutes. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 10 minutes. At the point, the inning in progress will be completed. If the game is a tie, the International Tie-Breaker Rule will be applied.**
- **Championship Games will have no time limit, 7 innings will be played and Run Rules will remain in effect.**
- **Run Rule: 12 after 3, 10 after 4, and 8 after 5.**
- **All Protests must be accompanied with a \$75 Fee. If Protest is upheld, Fee will be refunded.**
- **Should Inclement Weather occur, decisions will be made with the best interest of the Participants in mind. Decisions to shorten Time Limits to attempt to complete the Tournament will be left to the Sports Chair Person and the Bluegrass Sports Commission.**
