

## TOURNAMENT RULES

- This is an ASA Sanctioned Event. If you are not already sanctioned, you must do so before playing.
- ASA/KHSAA Rule will be enforced unless otherwise noted. ASA pitching rules in effect.
- Home Team will keep the Official Scorebook
- A Player is only allowed to play on one roster for the Tournament.
- You may “Roster Bat” or “Bat 9 in the Line-Up with 1 or 2 EP’s” (giving you 10 or 11 in the Batting Order) or “Bat 9 using the DP/Flex”. You cannot use an EP and the DP/Flex at the same time. An EP has free Substitution Rights. They can be moved in and out of the game without being reported.
- A Courtesy Runner (CR) can be used for the Pitcher and Catcher. It must be a player who has not played in the game. If there are no such players available, then the last batted out will be used. If the last batted out is the P or C, the next last batter out may be used. If the CR is on base when it is her turn to bat, she must be replaced on the base to bat by the next available CR or original runner. No OUTS will be called due to an incorrect CR; the incorrect CR will be replaced by the correct one.
- POOL PLAY - Time Limit is 1 hour and 10 minutes or 6 innings. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 10 minutes. At that point, the inning in progress will be completed. If the game is a tie, it will remain a tie and be recorded accordingly. Home Team determined by Coin Flip.
- TOURNAMENT PLAY - Time Limit is 1 hour and 15 minutes or 6 innings (10U/12U) or 7 innings for 14U and up. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 15 minutes. At that point, the inning in progress will be completed. If the game is a tie, the International Tie Breaker Rule will be applied until we have a Winner. The higher seeded team will be the “Home Team”.
- Championship Games will have no time limit but run rules apply; 6 innings for 10U/12U and 7 innings for 14U and up.
- Run Rule: 12 after 3, 10 after 4, and 8 after 5.
- All Protests must be accompanied with a \$75 Fee. If Protest is upheld, Fee will be refunded.
- EJECTIONS – Should an adult be ejected, he/she must immediately leave the premises. (Out of Sight, Out of Sound). Umpires have been instructed to call local law enforcement for non-compliance. Violators must apply to the Tournament Director for reinstatement after the conclusion of the game.
- Should Inclement Weather occur, decisions will be made with the best interest of the participants in mind. Decisions to shorten Time Limits to attempt to complete the Tournament will be left to the Tournament Director.
